

COVID-19 Liability Waiver and Affirmation of Conduct Restrictions

By registering to attend an event with Charitable Gift Planners of Connecticut (CGPCT), I agree to abide by all health and safety guidelines and recommendations that may be in place at the time by federal, state and local government agencies and officials, CGPCT, and the event venue. I further agree that I will not attend this event in-person if I become ill, am exposed to the COVID-19 virus within five days prior to the event or exhibit any symptoms of the COVID-19 virus prior to the event. At present, neither we nor the event venue are requiring proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test or the wearing of a mask, which may still be worn at the option of the attendee. These requirements may change depending on federal, state, and local government agencies and officials, CGPCT, and the event venue safety recommendations that may be in place at the time of the event. Additionally, I understand that travel to and participation in events may increase the risk of exposure to communicable diseases. I hereby release, waive and forever discharge any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature against CGPCT and its affiliated partners and sponsors, including in each case, without limitation, their directors, officers, employees, volunteers, independent contractors and agents (the “released parties”), either in law or in equity, to the fullest extent permissible by law, including but not limited to damages or losses caused by the negligence, fault or conduct of any kind on the part of the released parties, including but not limited to death, bodily injury, illness, economic loss or out of pocket expenses, or loss or damage to property, which I, my heirs, assignees, next of kin and/or legally appointed or designated representatives, may have or which may hereinafter accrue on behalf, which arise or may hereafter arise from my attendance at this event.
